- Driver's must display their wrist bands to the False Grid Official each time they leave to enter the race track.
- **ANY** transfer of fuel **MUST** include a separate designated person whose sole function shall be to oversee the refuelling process while holding an appropriate and armed fire extinguisher. Refuelling shall **NOT** be performed in Pit Lane, under an awning or where fumes could accumulate.
- Maximum permitted sound level is 104 db, only between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM.
- In a Red Flag situation, return slowly to Pit Lane or as otherwise directed.
- The Safety Kleen waste fluids disposal facility is located beside the chain link fence behind the Administration Building.
- The use of flying drones is not permitted at any time on the grounds of Calabogie Motorsports Park.
